	II.2.	The animals come from a population where there are no mortalities with an undetermined cause and where no mortalities due to Bsal or clinical signs of Bsal, in particular skin lesions and ulcers are observed.

			(ii) from which skin swab samples were taken during the fifth week of the quarantine and tested for Bsal with negative results with the appropriate diagnostic test, in accordance with the sample sizes laid down in point 1(a) of Annex III to Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2021/361]
	(3)	○ or	[salamanders which have been treated to the satisfaction of the competent authority against Bsal in accordance with point 1(b) of Annex III to Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2021/361]
	(3)	○ or	[salamanders which come from a confined establishment and are intended for another confined establishment]
	(3)	○ or	[salamanders which entered into the Union and have undergone quarantine or treatment and have been kept in the appropriate establishment of destination isolated from other salamanders between the end of the period of quarantine following their entry into the Union and the issuing of this certificate].
	II.4.	This certificate is valid for a period of 10 days from the date of issuing. In the case of transport by waterway/sea of animals, the period of validity of the certificate may be extended by the duration of the journey by waterway/sea.
