## Regulation of the State Veterinary Administration

The Central Veterinary Administration of the State Veterinary Administration, as the locally and factually competent administrative authority under the provisions of § 48 (1) (c) of Act No 166/1999, concerning veterinary care and amending certain related laws (Veterinary Act), as amended, with regard to Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 March 2016 on transmissible animal diseases and amending and repealing certain acts in the area of animal health ('Animal Health Legal Framework'), as amended (hereinafter referred to as "Regulation (EU) 2016/429"), Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687 of 17 December 2019 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards rules for the prevention and control of certain listed diseases, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "Regulation (EU) 2020/687"), Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/1882 of 3 December 2018 on the application of certain disease prevention and control rules to categories of listed diseases and establishing a list of species and groups of species posing a considerable risk for the spread of those listed diseases, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "Commission Regulation (EU) 2018/1882"), and in connection with restricted zones in areas with FMD established in Hungary and Slovakia, as well as in accordance with the provisions of § 54 (1) (d), (l) and (p), (2) (c) and (3), and § 57 (2) of Veterinary Act, shall order the following

### **Amendment to emergency veterinary measures Ref. No SVS/2025/050097 of 31 March 2025 issued for the protection of the state territory of the Czech Republic against the risk of intrusion of a dangerous contagious disease foot-and-mouth disease (hereinafter referred to as "FMD") from Hungary and Slovakia:**

#### **PART 1**

Article (4) shall read as follows:

#### **"Article 4**

- (1) Drivers of road vehicles and special vehicles weighting more than 3.5 tons transporting, or intended for the transport of animals, animal products, animal by-products, derived products, or feedingstuffs for farm animals to the Czech Republic shall use for crossing the state border from the Slovak Republic to the Czech Republic only the following border crossing points:
- a) Lanžhot – Brodské, border section IX/30/9 – IX/31 (original No), IX/31 (new No) highway D1, South Moravian Region;
  - b) Starý Hrozenkov – Drietoma; border section VI/28/4 – VI/28/5, road I/50, Zlín Region;
  - c) Bílá – Bumbálka – Makov, border section II/34/3, II 34/4 – II/34/5, III/3/7 – III/4, road I/35, Moravian-Silesian Region, or

- d) Mosty u Jablunkova – Svrčinovec, border section I/10 – I/10/2, road I/68, Moravian-Silesian Region.
- (2) Drivers of road vehicles and tractors weighting more than 3.5 tons shall use at crossing the state border from the Slovak Republic to the Czech Republic only the border crossing points referred to in paragraph (1) or the site designated for crossing the state border Hodonín – Holíč, border section IX/8/8 – IX/9 (original No), IX/9 (new No), road I/51, South Moravian Region.
- (3) Drivers referred to in paragraphs (1) and (2) shall suffer at crossing the state border the disinfection of transport means performed by the staff of the Fire Rescue Service.”

Article 4a shall read as follows:

#### **“Article 4a**

- (1) Operators of roads publicly accessible to vehicles of the total weight over 3.5 tons and tractors crossing the state border with the Slovak Republic, except for the sites designated for crossing the state border referred to in Article 4, shall without delay submit proposals concerning the establishment of a transitional arrangement of operation pursuant to § 77 (4) of Act on Road Traffic consisting in a ban on entry of these vehicles placed in the immediate vicinity of the state border in the direction of travel.
- (2) Operators of roads referred to in paragraph (1) shall furthermore place in the immediate vicinity of the ban on entry pursuant to paragraph (1) information boards with the data on sites designated for crossing the state border at which the entry of vehicles referred to in paragraph (1) to the Czech republic is authorised. The boards shall indicate the identification of the road concerned and the site designated for crossing the state border.”

## **PART 2**

### **Common and final provisions**

- (1) This Regulation shall come into force and effect pursuant to § 2 (1) and § 4 (1) and (2) of Act No 35/2021 on the Collection of legal rules of higher territorial self-governing units and certain administrative authorities due to threats to life, health, property, or environment on the day following its publication. The date and time of its publication shall be indicated in the Collection.
- (2) This Regulation shall be published on the official notice boards of the Ministry of Agriculture and Regional Offices of the territories concerned for at least 15 days and shall also be published without delay on the official web page of the State Veterinary Administration. Where the Regulation imposes duties on subjects other than keepers of farm animals, it shall be published in the national radio or television broadcasting as well.
- (3) The State Veterinary Administration shall publish information on the publication of the Regulation in the Collection on its official web page for at least 15 days from the day on which it has been notified of its publication.
