## Regulation of the State Veterinary Administration

The Central Veterinary Administration of the State Veterinary Administration, as the locally and factually competent administrative authority pursuant to the provisions of § 48 (1) (c) of Act No 166/1999, concerning veterinary care and amending certain related laws (Veterinary Act), as amended, with regard to Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 March 2016 on transmissible animal diseases and amending and repealing certain acts in the area of animal health ('Animal Health Legal Framework'), as amended (hereinafter referred to as "Regulation (EU) 2016/429"), Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687 of 17 December 2019 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards rules for the prevention and control of certain listed diseases, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "Regulation (EU) 2020/687"), Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/1882 of 3 December 2018 on the application of certain disease prevention and control rules to categories of listed diseases and establishing a list of species and groups of species posing a considerable risk for the spread of those listed diseases, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "Commission Regulation (EU) 2018/1882"), and in connection with restricted zones in areas with FMD established in Hungary and Slovakia, as well as in accordance with the provisions of § 54 (1) (d), (l), (o), and (p), (2) (c) and (3), and § 57 (2) of Veterinary Act, shall order the following

### PART ONE

1. In Article (1), paragraph (2) shall read as follows:

"(2) Legal persons and natural persons involved in business shall comply with ban on the movement of

- a) animal products other than subjected to the treatment pursuant to Annex VII to Regulation (EU) 2020/687;
- b) animal by-products

originating from Hungary or the Slovak Republic to the Czech Republic."

2. In Article (1), paragraph (4) shall read as follows:

"(4) Ban on the movement of products referred to in paragraph (2) shall not apply to products accompanied by the veterinary certificate attested by the competent authority of the Slovak republic or Hungary within the TRACES NT system."

3. In Article (1) (5), the introductory part and letter (a) shall read as follows:

"(5) Ban on the movement of products referred to in paragraph (3) shall not apply to products

a) accompanied by the veterinary certificate attested by the competent authority of the Slovak republic or Hungary within the TRACES NT system.”

4. In Article (5) (2) , letter (b) shall read as follows:

“b) Bílá-Bumbálka – Makov, border section II/34/3, II 34/4 – II/34/5, road No I/35, Moravian-Silesian Region; after the disinfection performed at that place pursuant to paragraph (3), drivers of vehicles going on the indicated diversion route Hutisko-Solanec/Velké Karlovice can use for crossing border from the Slovak Republic to the Czech Republic the place intended for crossing the border Bílá-Bumbálka – Makov, border section III/3/7 – III/4, road No II/487, Region Zlín. In such cases, the drivers shall ask for an attestation of performed disinfection which they shall have available for all the journey and submit it for control upon request. The disinfection could not be performed in the cases when drivers going on the indicated diversion route Hutisko-Solanec/Velké Karlovice from the Czech Republic from the border section II/34/3, II 34/4 – II/34/5, road No I/35, Moravian-Silesian Region, to border section III/3/7 – III/4, road No II/487, Region Zlín use for crossing border the place Bílá-Bumbálka – Makov, border section III/3/7 - III/4, road No II/487, Region Zlín.”.

5. In Article (7) (1), letters (f) and (g) shall be repealed.

## **PART TWO**

### **Common and final provisions**

(1) This Regulation shall pursuant to § 2 (1) and § 4 (1) and (2) of Act No 35/2021 on the Collection of legal rules of higher territorial self-governing units and certain administrative authorities due to an urgent public interest come into force on the day of its publication in the Collection and into effect on the beginning of the day following the day of its publication. The date and time of its publication shall be indicated in the Collection.

(2) This Regulation shall be published on the official notice boards of the Ministry of Agriculture and Regional Offices of the territories concerned for at least 15 days and shall also be published without delay on the official web page of the State Veterinary Administration. Where the Regulation imposes duties on subjects other than keepers of farm animals, it shall be published in the national radio or television broadcasting as well.

(3) The State Veterinary Administration shall publish information on the publication of the Regulation in the Collection on its official web page for at least 15 days from the day on which it has been notified of its publication.
